

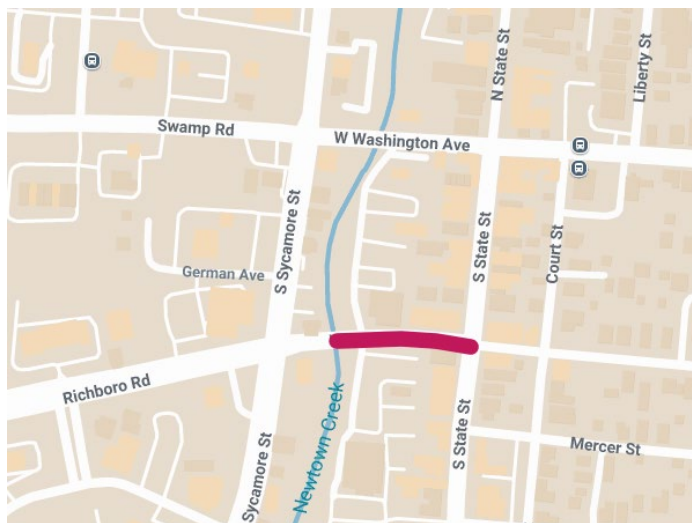


## Notice of Utility Work on Centre Avenue

Issued May 16<sup>th</sup> 2025

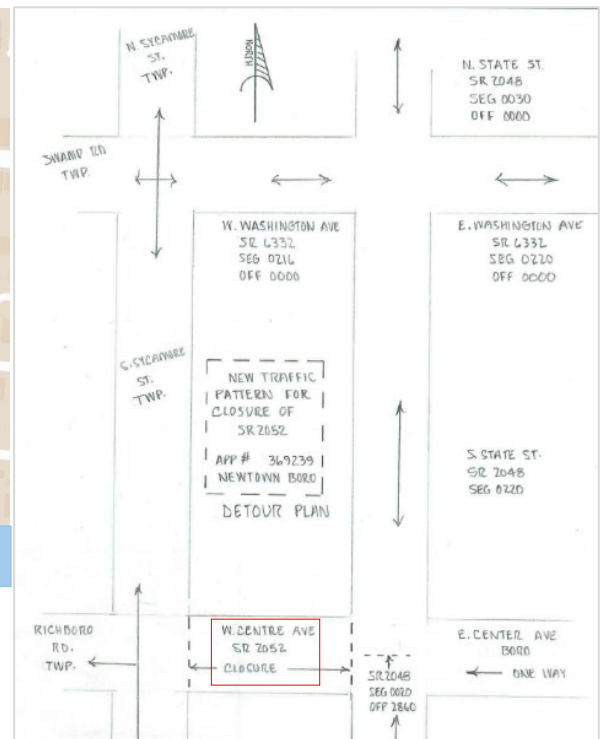
Dear Businesses and Residents,

The Borough was recently notified by the **Newtown Artesian Water Company** of its plans to upgrade the water main beneath the unit block of West Centre Avenue, between the Newtown Creek and State Street. This project is scheduled to begin on or about **Monday, June 2**, and is expected to take approximately **two (2) weeks** to complete.

During construction, this one-block section of Centre Avenue will be **closed to traffic in both directions between the hours of 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM each day**.

As this is a state-owned roadway, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) has required the Newtown Artesian Water Company to develop a detour plan. This plan has been submitted and approved by both the Borough and the state, and is set forth herein. ## Notice of Utility Work State Street, Penn Street and Centre Avenue

Dear Businesses and Residents,

This notice is for residents and businesses located in or near the Central Business District, specifically along **South State Street** and the **unit and 100 blocks of Penn Street** (the section between State Street and Chancellor Street) in Newtown Borough.

Beginning on or about June 1<sup>st</sup> 2025, **PECO's Natural Gas Division** will begin an underground utility project to replace the existing gas main and associated service laterals connecting to properties along South State Street and Penn Street. The project is expected to continue through the summer and fall of 2025.



Construction will proceed in small sections, starting at Centre Avenue and progressing south along State Street toward Freedom Drive/Fountain Farm Lane.

As part of the project, **State Street will be fully closed in both directions, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for approximately two (2) months.** This closure is necessary to allow for trenching and boring work at two major infrastructure points: Boring under the railroad tracks near 500 South State Street and boring beneath the stormwater culvert at the intersection of State Street and Sterling Street.

Outside of this full closure period, State Street will remain open but will be subject to lane shifts and controlled traffic patterns to safely accommodate excavation work while maintaining pass-through access.

Detour routes and additional details will be provided prior to the closure and as work progresses. The Borough and PECO will coordinate to minimize disruption and maintain access as much as possible.
