t <u>Limitations</u>
Garage sale permits shall be issued to any one (1) person only twice within a twelvemonth period, and no such permit shall be issued to any one (1) person for more than one (1) day.

Garage sale permit shall be issued not more than two (2) times within a twelve-В. month period for any one (1) premises.

- Charitable and religious and civic organizations may be allowed more than two (2) C. permits within a twelve-month period upon approval of same by the Council of the Borough of Newtown.
- Each permit issued under this chapter must be prominently displayed on the D. premises upon which the garage sale is conducted throughout the entire period of the sale.

Hours of Sale:

All garage sales shall be conducted only between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., and no permit shall be issued for such sales on Sundays and days declared holidays by the United States of America or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

No garage sale shall be conducted on either the first Saturday in June nor the first Saturday in December. Garage sales are also prohibited on any day which is declared a holiday by the Mayor of Newtown Borough. (大雅) A. Lingth

reamble time was Only one (1) sign advertising such sale shall be permitted. The sign shall not exceed four (4) square feet on a side. All such signs shall be posted on the premises where such sale is conducted and must contain the name and address of the person conducting the sale and the date on which the permit was issued for such sale. Signs must be removed within twenty four (24) hours after completion of the sale and shall not be posted more than fortyeight (48) hours prior to the hour on which the sale is to be commenced. and a realist to apply the first

Persons and sales exempted.

The provisions of this Chapter shall not apply to or affect the following persons or sales:

- Α. Persons selling goods pursuant to an order or process of a court of competent
- В. Persons acting in accordance with their powers and duties as public officials.
- Any person selling or advertising for sale an item or items of personal property C. which are specifically named or described in the advertisement and which separate items do not exceed three (3) in number.
- Any publisher of a newspaper, magazine or other publication or other communication media who publishes or broadcasts in good faith without knowledge of its false, deceptive or misleading character or without knowledge that the provisions of this chapter have not been complied with.

Responsibility for good order.

The person to whom such license is issued and the owner or tenant of the premises on which such sale or activity is conducted shall be jointly and severally responsible for the maintenance of good order and decorum on the premises during all hours of such sale or activity. No such person shall permit any loud or boisterous conduct on said premises nor permit vehicles to impede the passage of traffic on any roads or streets in the area of such premises. ministry to the second

Violations and penalties.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and costs of prosecution for each offense, and upon default in payment of the fine and costs, by imprisonment in the county jail for a term of not more than thirty (30) days.
